

ACUTE CARE

Upper Murray Health & Community Services has ten acute hospital beds. Patients are admitted by one of the General Practitioners and cared for by our multi-skilled nursing team. In this hospital we offer the following services:

- Rehabilitation
- Acute Aged Care
- Post Acute Care
- Palliative Care
- Emergency Respite Care
- Mental Health care for low risk clients

We also have a High Dependency Unit (HDU) which is used to treat and stabilise critical ill clients and then transfer these emergency clients to major hospitals.

Visitors are most welcome at any time but consideration needs to be given to clients treatment and rest. Ministers of Religion will visit the ward on request. We also work closely with Community Services to ensure a holistic approach to your care.

On discharge you will be provided with a discharge summary detailing your follow up appointments for services as well as information on your medication. Our philosophy is to ensure that your journey and experience of our health systems should be an enjoyable experience.
